

# Clinical Case Study: Surgical Site Wound

- **Patient Information:** 54-year old female
- **Wound History:** 4-week old surgical site wound after dehiscence of hip replacement surgery incision, initially treated with iodoform packing.
- **Dimensions:** Prior to SNaP® Therapy, the wound measured 15 mm x 12 mm, with a depth of 10 mm.
- **Comorbidities:** Diabetes and obesity.
- **SNaP® Therapy Treatment:** The patient was treated with the SNaP® Therapy device for 3 weeks until wound filled in and was fully granulated.
- **Outcome:** At that point, the wound had become superficial and treatment was continued with an absorbent foam dressing until complete healing occurred 3 weeks later.

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
