Its first product is the SNaP® Wound Care System, which is the result of patient and clinician feedback that current negative pressure wound therapies were too cumbersome. Spiracur strives to develop products that are truly patient-centric.

Products and Intended Use:	The SNaP Wound Care System is an ultraportable, single-use negative pressure wound therapy (NPWT) device, cleared by the U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA) in August 2009 in a new therapy category defined as “non-powered” NPWT devices. The device was also CE Marked in the European Union in December 2010. The SNaP Wound Care System is indicated for patients who would benefit from a suction device for wound healing and further indicated for removal of small amounts of exudate (fluid) from chronic, acute, traumatic, subacute and dehisced wounds, as well as ulcers (diabetic or pressure) and surgically closed incisions.
Product Description:	The SNaP System’s inventive design eliminates the electric or battery powered pump used to deliver NPWT. The device is completely silent, lightweight (2.2 ounces) and discreet so it fits easily under clothing.
